Blessing of Throats

The Memorial of Saint Blaise occurred on Thursday, February 3, 2022.

This weekend, February 5 and 6, we will bless throats at all Masses.

Because individuals may feel reluctant to come forward to receive an individual blessing of their throat for the Feast of St. Blaise, a general blessing, which is equally efficacious, will be given.

Following the general blessing, those who wish to receive the sacramental sign of the individual blessing of their throats with candles, will be asked to come forward. The ministers administering the individual blessings with candles are required to wear a mask.

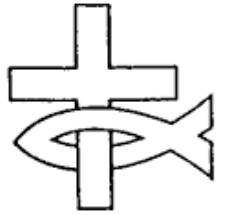
Sacrament of Confirmation Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist
