### **Social Concerns**

#### **“Project, Back to School”**

This summer our Social Concerns Committees from Corpus Christi and St. Barbara Parishes are teaming up to collect donations of new back-to-school supplies, new hygiene products and non-perishable food. Our goal is to enable local families, who may be struggling financially, to equip their children with the back-to-school supplies they need. Donations may be left in the vestibules of the churches or dropped off at the rectory.



►Establishing proper hygiene is key to a sense of self and better health. If you can help, we are asking for donations of personal hygiene products for children aged toddler thru teen. Some suggested items could include: **brushes, combs, chapstick, shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, dry shampoo, ponytail holders, shaving cream, soap, body-wash, toothbrushes, toothpaste and mouthwash.**

►Some suggestions for back-to-school supplies could include: **pens, pencils, folders, composition books, spiral notebooks, wide ruled and college ruled paper, binders, pencil sharpeners, highlighters, pencil pouches, calculators, ear buds, staplers, rulers and hand sanitizers.**

►Suggestions for non-perishable food donations could include: **peanut butter, jelly, pastas, sauces, rice, canned meats and tuna, breakfast foods including hot and cold cereals, oatmeal, pancake mix, syrup, breakfast bars, puddings, jello, cookies and crackers.**

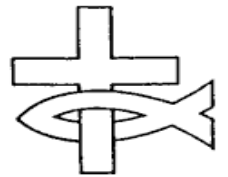
