As previously mentioned, because of the subdivision requirements, we must await completion of the new school parking lot before the church facility sale can be completed. Dear Wyoming Area Catholic School Families,

We write to update you regarding the latest plans for the sale of St. Cecilia's Church and the new parking lot at Wyoming Area Catholic School.

As noted in our January communication, there are many steps to the process of selling St. Cecilia's Church, which includes installing a new parking lot for Wyoming Area Catholic School. As you may recall, in order to be in compliance with Exeter borough's legal subdivision requirements and Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Highway Occupancy Permit (HOP) requirements are necessary. For reference, these requirements principally include: 1) the establishment of a new parking lot exclusively for the school since the current parking lot must be sold with the church to fulfill off-street parking minimums, and 2) improvement to the Wyoming Avenue entranceway to ensure safety once the church property is sold.

To our surprise, the HOP took much longer than expected to obtain from PennDOT. While we have recently achieved this step of obtaining the HOP, the delay significantly impacts the ability to complete the project within the original timeline. Due to this delay, and with the safety of our students at the forefront of our decision-making, we will be postponing the project until next spring. While this delay was unexpected, we are committed to this project and will continue to take steps to see this project come to fruition.

As always, thank you for your commitment to Catholic education at Wyoming Area Catholic School. May God continue to bless you and your families!


Social Concerns "Project, Back to School"
