For low income families, this is just about impossible. We put together a list of back to school items needed by every child, depending on his or her grade. Whether you choose from the list below or donate any other items, they will be greatly appreciated!!

- Backpacks (elementary thru high school)
- #2 pencils/pens (blue, black, red)
- Colored pencils (8-10 colors)
- Markers (wide 8-10), crayons (24 box)
- Pencil pouches (for 3 ring binder), pencil boxes
- Pencil sharpeners
- Calculators (simple or scientific)
- Scissors (elementary/Friskars)
- Paper (wide ruled & college ruled)
- Notebooks (spiral & composition, 1 or more subject)
