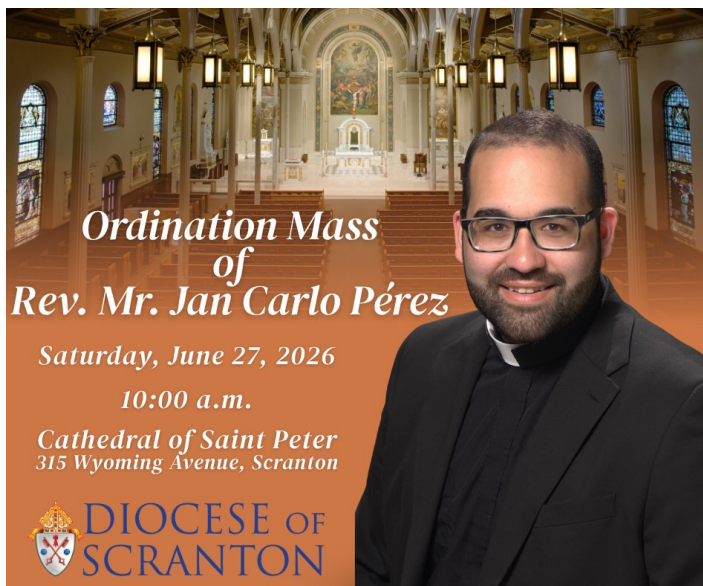
**Fresh Ham Dinner**
